Responding to Your Comments

(from August 2006 Open House)

Comment	Response
Concerns about removing on-street parking on Liberty Street south of the intersection.	A left turn lane on Liberty Street is needed, but has been shortened to allow on-street parking within limits shown.
Turning onto Liberty from Franklin is uncomfortable and dangerous because of the steep valley gutter north of Franklin.	The ACHD Maintenance Division is currently reviewing options to improve the valley gutter prior to the construction of this project.
Sidewalk and road improvements are needed further north from what is shown for this project.	This is an intersection improvement project intended to improve traffic capacity and safety at the intersection by installing a traffic signal and left turn lanes.
	 Continuous sidewalk will be constructed within the project limits. Constructing a temporary pathway on the east side connecting to the apartment complex is being explored.
	 Ask an ACHD representative about Community Programs, an application process frequently used to get funding for curb, gutter and sidewalk projects.
