



Two-Stage Pedestrian Crossing

- Pedestrians cross the street in two stages, crossing one direction of traffic at a time with a walk signal.
- At each stage pedestrians only have to look in one direction at a time.



Trucks

- The U-turn is designed so large vehicles and trucks can easily make the U-turn.



Bicycling

- Bicyclists have several options including:
- Follow the same left-turn route as vehicles
 - Dismount and use the pedestrian crossings



ThrU-Turn

Instead of turning left at the intersection, left-turn traffic on State Street will:

- Continue through the intersection
- Perform a U-turn at a downstream traffic signal
- Head back toward the intersection
- Make a right turn
