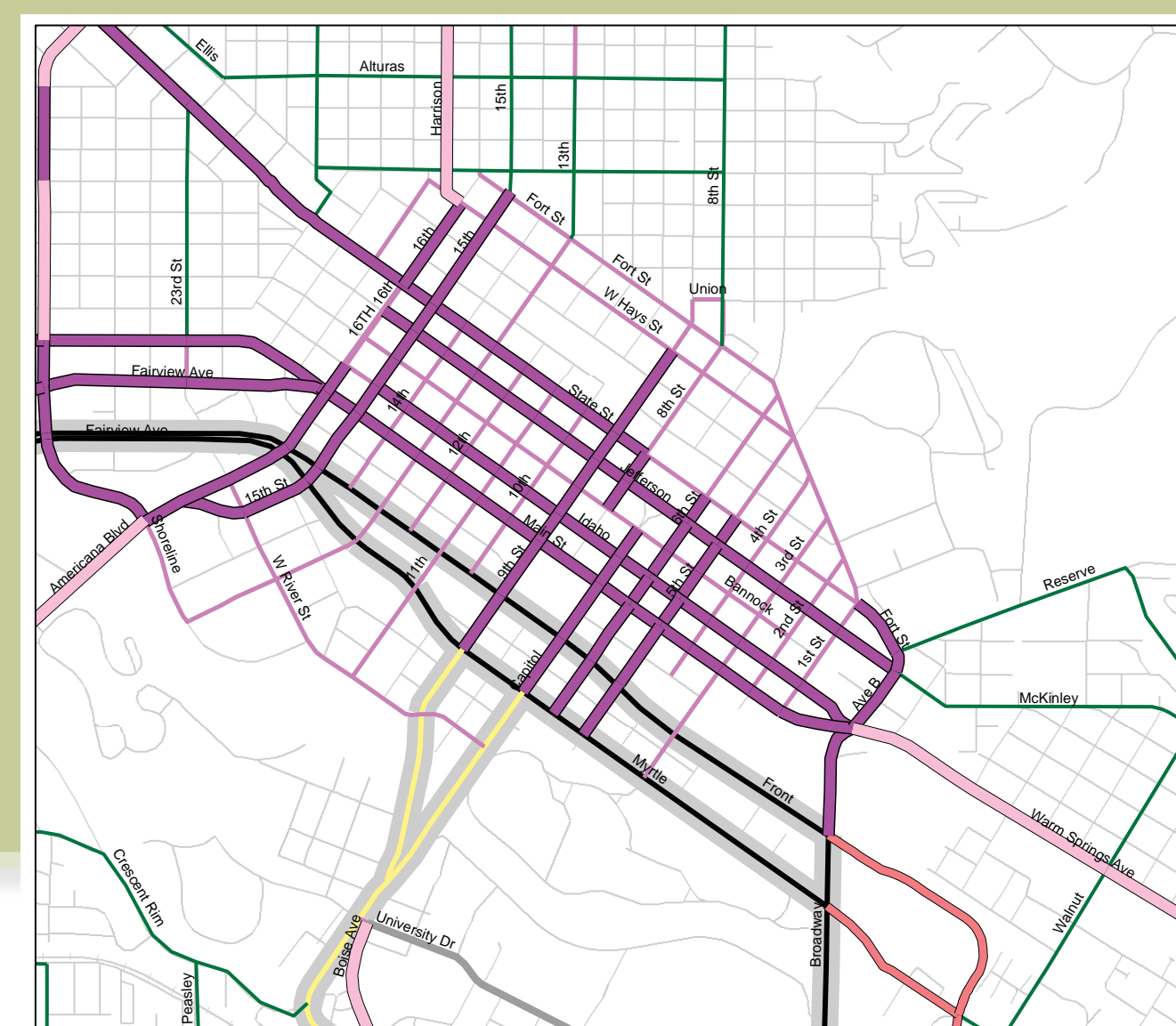


Definitions



A transportation network has several types of roadways:

- State highways/interstates (Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) jurisdiction)
- Arterials - major roads that serve longer trips (ACHD jurisdiction)
- Collectors - roads that connect arterials and provide direct access to schools and shopping (ACHD jurisdiction)
- Local/Residential - smaller roadways that serve homes and neighborhoods (ACHD jurisdiction)



Example:

13th Street, a collector, links local streets in Boise's north end to arterials like State, Main and Front streets.
